Bias Lace Scarf Two 2-hour sessions. A great introduction to simple lace knitting, this scarf creates diagonal stripes using self-striping yarn and knitting on the bias. Buy or bring supplies (list provided at registration). \$40

Fair-Isle Wrist Warmers (Color Work for Novices)

Two 2-hour sessions. Learn the basics of knitting with two colors and how to follow a chart with these simple Fair Isle wrist warmers. Ribbing on both edges provides for greater versatility than traditional Fair Isle mittens. Buy or bring supplies (list provided at registration). \$40

Steeked Wrist Warmers Two 2-hour sessions. We will make a pair of color work wrist warmers to introduce you to this emotionally scary but easy technique, giving you the courage to take the scissors to your knitting in future. 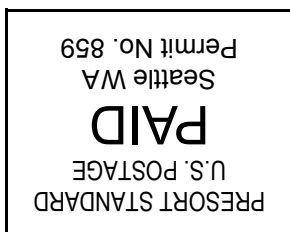
