After 7 1/2 years at 7000 Greenwood Avenue-North, we're excited to announce that the store is moving. Our new location is 8212 Greenwood Avenue North, 12 blocks north of the existing store (see the map on the back page of this newsletter).

The new space has some great features: customer parking behind the building (enter off

of 83rd Street North), air conditioning for those hot summer days, and more stock room space behind the scenes. It's conveniently located halfway between the post office and the library, and close to the restaurants and stores of downtown Greenwood.

We will be closed January 3 to 5 for the move, reopening in the new space January 6.

Our winter knitalong: an easy sweater with sophisticated details

Join us for our winter knitalong, Grayling by Cecily Glowik MacDonald. This is an easy jacket knit from the top down in garter stitch. Despite its simple construction, it has a fresh, modern silhouette and can be worn open or pinned. Optional medallion details on the sleeves and lower hem add a layer of sophistication. The sweater is knit with DK-weight yarn knit at worsted gauge to create a loose weave and flattering drape.

The kickoff event is Saturday, January 28 from 4 to 6 p.m. We'll help you select yarn and get started while we offer refreshments and give away door prizes.

As usual we'll have several informal sessions during the winter during which our staff will be available for help with the project. The session schedule can be found inside the newsletter.

The knitalong wraps up April 22, with a grand prize winner selected from those in attendance who have finished the project.

Meanwhile, don't forget that the wrapup for our fall knitalong, the Vonica sweater, is Saturday, January 6 from 5 to 6. Bring your finished

sweater to show off, enjoy refreshments and enter our grand prize drawing.

Bias Lace Scarf: Two 2-hour sessions. A great introduction to simple lace knitting, this scarf creates diagonal stripes using self-striping yarn and knitting on the bias. **\$40**

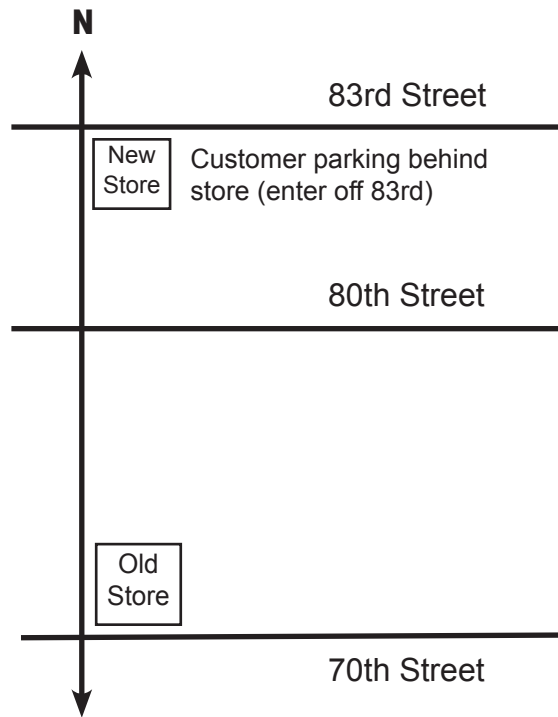
We have too much yarn! Help us reduce our inventory during our one-day smash moving sale on New Year's Eve. All yarn in the store will be 20 percent off for one day only.
